



2015 SPONSORED WALK

Background: As an alternative to its annual fun day, Pattrington Cricket Club is organising a sponsored (approximately 7.5 miles) walk for club members and friends, on Sunday 31st May. It's hoped the club will be able to raise a target of £1,500, to further improve equipment and facilities at its Southside Cricket Ground, both to help the club expand its junior section and to support refurbishment of the clubhouse - especially for the benefit of spectators.

Route: The leisurely walk will begin at the Crown & Anchor pub, Kilnsea, with participants treated to magnificent views of the Humber estuary, for two thirds of the route, whilst walking along the Humber bank. After passing Easington, Skeffling, Weeton and Welwick, there'll be a wonderful amble through the little-known and peaceful Haverfield Quarry (also known locally as Saltmarsh), a former nature reserve. With St Patrick's Church drawing ever closer, the final leg of the walk will involve a trek along a bridleway, through farmland, passing Pattrington playing fields, and arriving at Southside - just in time for the start of the 3rd team's match against Sutton 3rd XI, and some well-deserved 'on the house' refreshments for all walkers. Please note, in the interests of safety, the route will not involve having to walk alongside public highways. However, all walkers are advised to use suitable footwear (preferably walking boots). A shorter (approximately 4.5 miles) route is being organised for a start at Skeffling Humber Bank.

Any member that raises more than £100, will be entered into a prize draw, with some great prizes to be won.
