



2014 Junior Player Code of Conduct

The cricket club is fully committed to safeguarding and the promoting the well being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches administrators and parents associated with the club should at all times, show respect, be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Junior Cricket organiser (Andrew Guy).

As a Junior Member of Patrington Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the general rules of the club –

- - Members must play cricket within the laws and in the spirit of the game.
- - Members must respect colleagues, opponents and officials at all times.
- - Members must be polite to umpires and respect their decisions.
- - Members should keep to agreed timings for practices and matches or inform their coach at the earliest possible opportunity if they cannot play or are going to be late.
- - Members must wear the appropriate kit. Cricket whites are required for all matches, but tracksuits etc are permitted for training.
- - All players under the age of 18 years must wear helmets when batting and when wicket keeping (standing up)
- - Players must wear suitable underpants and use an abdominal guard (box) whenever batting against a hard ball in either training or in matches.



2014 Junior Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

As a parent/guardian of a Junior Member of Patrington Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the general rules of the club –

- - Encourage your child to learn the laws of the game and to play within the spirit of those laws.**
- - Discourage unfair play and disputes with officials/coaches.**
- - Help your child recognise good performance, not just results.**
- - Never force your child to play sport against their will.**
- - Set a good example by recognising fair play and by applauding the good performances of all.**
- - Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.**
- - Publicly accept the decisions of officials without argument or comment.**
- - Use the correct and proper language at all times.**
